TCC Code of Conduct Policy

The following document covers the levels of conduct expected from all players, officials and supporters (both Tintwistle CC and visitors).

On Field Conduct

The club expect all TCC and visiting players to adhere to the code of conducted set out by the Derbyshire and Cheshire Cricket League.

All breaches of this code of conduct will be dealt with by the clubs disciplinary committee and where applicable the league disciplinary committee.

In addition to the leagues code of conduct Tintwistle CC have a ZERO tolerance to any threatening or abusive behaviour (both physical and verbally). Any instances of this against any player on the cricket field will be dealt with immediately by the club and the individual will be asked to leave the ground with immediate effect (regardless of the position of the game). If appropriate the police will be informed and assistance from them requested.

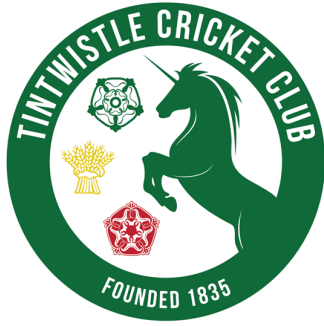
Dressing Room

All Tintwistle players and visiting players will treat the dressing room facilities with respect and leave them in the state they were found.

Again, any instances of physical or verbal abuse within the dressing room will be dealt with as per the above.

Child welfare within these environments is also paramount to the club. All junior players should only be in the dressing room when an appropriate adult is present (parent or DBS registered individual such as captain, coach or Safeguarding officer). Other Areas of the ground and clubhouse

All visitors to the club are expected to act responsibly and respect others around them. The committee reserve the right to ask anyone to leave the club grounds if their behaviour is deemed unacceptable. Items that fall into this category (list not exhaustive) are:

1. Physical abuse
2. Verbal abuse
3. Other anti-social behaviour
4. Intoxication
5. Discriminatory behaviour
6. Causing damage to club property

Drugs and Alcohol

The club have a ZERO policy to the existence and use of any drugs on the grounds or within the clubhouse. If anyone is found in possession or using drugs on the premises, they will be asked to leave and the police will be informed and assistance from them requested.

Alcohol will be served at the club bar during agreed opening hours. The club reserve the right to refuse anyone if they feel it appropriate due to their age, physical state of intoxication or other valid reason.
